Workshop to explain Winsted charter

WINSTED - The town's community lawyer will hold the second of two workshops to educate residents about the town charter on May 22.

The session is at 7 p.m. in Room 306 at Northwestern Connecticut Community College. The first session was held yesterday.

"Although most citizens are aware that there is a charter, many don't know what it means," Charlene LaVoie said. The session will explain the

charter's purpose and review proposed charter revisions, she said.

LaVoie said while the charter is undergoing revision, residents have the perfect opportunity to learn about the document and ask questions about its purpose and powers.

LaVoie said the workshop will give residents a chance to "hear and learn and talk about the charter and what it means in the town."

WINSTED - A workshop to help residents understand the town's charter, its purpose, and changes to the document that are being proposed will be held tonight at 7 p.m. in Room 306 at Northwestern Connecticut Community College.

LaVoie said the workshop will help residents to educate themselves on the changes proposed for the charter. The Board of Selectmen is currently reviewing the changes to the document that have been recommended by the Charter Revision Commission.

Once approved by selectmen residents will vote on the charter changes in November.
